



Family owned wine estate since 20's when the great grandfather of the current owner aquire it. The vineyard is located around a mill at the north of the small village of Caussan, in Blaignan near Lesparre, Médoc.

Since 2019, the estate is certified High Environmental Value level 3 (HVE 3) and since 2021, certified Organic Vineyard.

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#### 2022 VINTAGE

Harvest : Vending machine

Harvest reception : manual sorting, draining, destemming, mechanical sorting of the grape seeds, crushing, an vatting.

Winemaking : Médoc tradition (daily pumping over, temperature control, 21 days vating time)

Blend : Cabernet franc 100%

Aging : Stainless steel vats during 4 monthes

Tasting notes : Serve fresh with grilled meat, barbecue, salad or fruit tart.
