

Sous le Platane

Family owned wine estate since 20's when the great grandfather of the current owner aquire it. The vineyard is located around a mill at the north of the small village of Caussan, in Blaignan near Lesparre, Médoc.

Since 2019, the estate is certified High Environmental Value level 3 (HVE 3) and since 2031, certified Organic Vineyard.
