



# Château Le Tertre de Caussan 2016

## Medoc AOC

Château Le Tertre de Caussan is located in Blaignan, in the heart of Medoc appellation. Since 2011, Nicolas Caussan is the manager of this family operation that was created in the 1930's by his great grand father. The first ever parcels circled a mill on a hill near de Caussan village. Hence the name of the chateau.



**Vineyard's surface** : 20,52 ha

**Yield** : 55 hl/ha

**Types of soil** : Clay-limestone

**Vine population** : Merlot 52% Cabernet Sauvignon 48%

**Average age of the vineyard** : 26 years old

**Plant density** : 5000 foot/ha

**Pruning** : Guyot double/ Medocan pruning

**Cultivation methods** : grass between rows, chemical or mechanical weeding under the row.

**Wine harvest** : Mechanical

**Vinification** : Coated steel tank , coated concrete et stainless steel

**Maceration** : in total 21 days of vatting

**Maceration temperature** : 28 °C

**Ageing** : Tank and 20% in two wines barrels

**Volume of alcohol** : 14,5%

**Bottling** : Provider

**Marketing** : direct/winery departure

**Serving temperature** : 18 – 20°C

**Keeping advice** : To drink now or to keep for 8 to 10 years.

**Food and wine matches** : Smooth and fresh wine to discover during your meal with meat.
